What is SEAL?

SEAL stands for Select Entry Accelerated Learning Program. The SEAL Program at Mordialloc College is designed for gifted and high achieving students who are looking to accelerate in their learning.

How long has the SEAL Program been running?

The accredited SEAL Program has been running at Mordialloc College since 1997. We are extremely proud of our membership with The Academy of Accredited SEAL Schools (TAASS) and our program is regularly reviewed for accreditation on purposes to ensure that we continue to deliver the best possible educational outcomes for our students.

How will my child benefit from the SEAL program?

There are a wide array of educational benefits that derive from participating in this program, some include:

- Opportunity to work with 'like minded' students
- Increased motivation and confidence
- Wide range of curricular and extra-curricular experiences
- Fast paced curriculum (optimising VCE enhancement opportunities)

What does the application process involve?

All students wishing to apply for this program must:

1. Be accepted in to Mordialloc College (as per the Application for Year 7 Placement 2027 process via Primary Schools)
2. Register interest in the 2027 SEAL Program via the link on the Mordialloc College website. This link is to register with Edutest, the provider of our entrance exam and includes paying a non-refundable fee of \$90 (plus GST)
3. Upload a compiled portfolio to the Edutest site (Grade 5 semester 2 report, Grade 6 semester 1 report, Grade 5 NAPLAN scores)
4. Sit a series of entrance exams conducted by Edutest at Mordialloc College
5. Provide the school with the name of a current classroom teacher to complete an online reference form (which will be emailed directly to them)
6. Participate in an interview with the SEAL Coordinator & Mordialloc College Principal

When can I register my interest in the SEAL Program for 2027?

The link to Edutest on the Mordialloc College website will go live from Thursday June 25th 2026. Please note that you need to ensure you have received notification of a placement offer at Mordialloc College for 2027 (from your Primary school) prior to registering your interest.

Once you have registered, you will receive further communication from Mordialloc College regarding testing date (Thursday August 20th 2026), location, time and what to bring.

Who runs the entrance exam?

We employ Edutest to conduct our academic testing. This company is highly regarded by members of the TAASS network and Edutest results are transferrable to multiple SEAL school applications. Practice exams are accessible via the Edutest website, which enable students to prepare for the exams. Mordialloc College does not release exam results to parents as we triangulate all data sets to ensure we select the most suitable candidates for our SEAL Program. Edutest charge \$90 (plus GST) per student to conduct testing.

**Registration costs are set by our testing company and no profits are made by the College throughout the testing process.*

Are there costs involved with the program?

Yes, there is a SEAL levy that is paid each year to cover extra-curricular opportunities that are offered to students in the program.

How much is the SEAL levy in Year 7?

The Year 7 SEAL levy will be \$65 in 2027. This covers the cost of entry into national competitions. A non-refundable deposit is required on acceptance of the offer.
